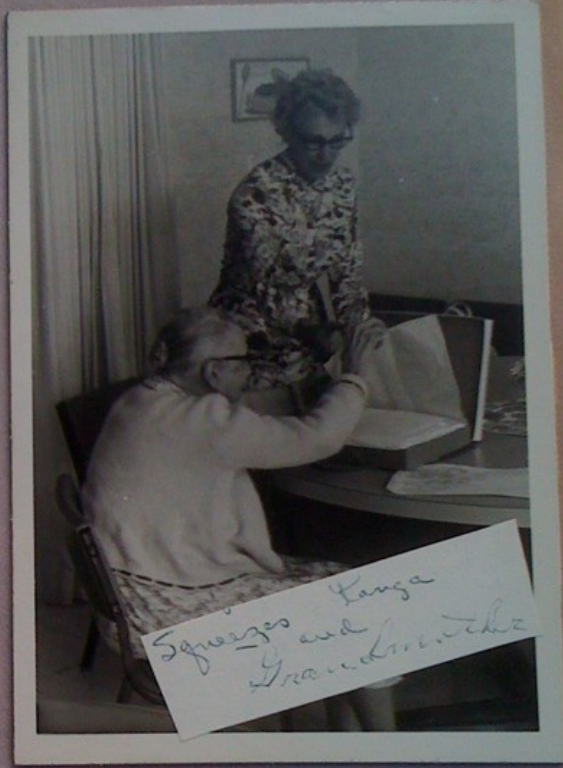

I urge you to trust yourself. Reach into your perceptions, bring them to the surface and verbalize them. It is this kind of global knowledge that has been covered over and ignored throughout patriarchal history, much to everyone's great loss. Women are now about bringing their wisdom to the surface, verbalizing it and acting --not on conventional wisdom but on the interpretation of their own experiences.
